The Mozambique Historical Archives is also National Archives. It gives advices on records and archives management policy to Central Director of The National System of State Archives and coordinates the implementation of archives management activities at central, provincial, district and municipal levels. The activities that are out lined here referred to the period from 2022-2023. During that period of time the Mozambique Historical Archives implemented its plan of activities complying with organisational regulations as the key tool for university governance in context of strategic planning.

Due to the lack of sufficient financial resources the Mozambique Historical Archives was unable to carry out other significant activities at national level in terms of monitoring, and other activities with regard to the records appraisal processes guided by the National System of State Archives legislation. The key areas were research, technical support to National System of State Archives, records and archives management and training of organisational staff and students from schools and universities. Thus, the key activities carried out are as follows:
